



## BEDROOMS AND LAYOUT OF THE PRIORY

This 13th century, Grade 1 listed Priory is the former gatehouse to an Augustinian monastery founded in 1171. The property can sleep 13 in 4 beautifully styled bedrooms.

Here's a list of all available bedrooms:

| Bedroom           | Sleeps   | Beds        | Description   |
|-------------------|--|-------------|---|
| Mary-Rose Room    | 1 super-king, pair of daybeds if required      | 2-4         | Super king-sized bed, painted wooden floors, and rugs, free-standing bath and separate WC. The windows face east and south overlooking the garden. There is a day bed, which sleeps two.  |
| Tudor Room        | 1 super-king 4-poster, 2 camp-beds if required | 2-4         | The magnificent bridal suite, with a four-poster bed, has a stunning 15ft high arched window, where the sun streams in. South facing, it overlooks the peaceful garden planted with scented roses and lavender, where Henry VIII's sister Mary once walked. Ensuite bathroom with shower and a separate free-standing bath. An additional comfortable day bed sleeps two. |
| De Glanville Room | 1 super-king, pair of daybeds if required      | 2-4         | The largest bedroom in the house with a super king-sized bed, free standing bath and basin. The south facing window and window seat overlooks the garden. An extra day bed sleeps two. The WC is shared with the Monk's Cell down a flight of stairs.   |
| Monk's Cell       | One single bed                                 | 1           | This tiny but characterful single room overlooks the front grounds of The Priory. It has its own bathroom and a WC shared with the de Glanville bedroom. The bedroom is reached by a flight of stairs.  |
